First 24 hours most important for search and rescue

PE program – revitalizing our fitness studio, we are looking at multi-purpose room alongside the fitness studio. We are looking at outside equipment, fitness stations outside and connecting with Saanich for grant funding and community funding resources. Plan is to have life-skills groups in the multi-purpose area – a place of purpose for our students. Measurements are being taken this week and we hope to move forward with further planning.

In transition with our grade 8's. The process will have opportunity to go through core selection process. Transition day for our students to go to the schools to do course selection – Oak Bay, Reynolds, Vic High will come to the school to help with course planning – March 2. Transition day will be in May.

Discussion on pre-transition numbers for students coming into Lansdowne next September 2017 - early French numbers increasing by 1 class. School size due to increase to 580. In four years the student projections are close to 700.

Computer lab in portable will become a classroom. We need to find another classroom in our building.

Pro D day – fantastic pro-d day: numeracy specialist, literacy, GAF, french immersion.

Open house for grade 5's tomorrow night.

Tech packages – last year we had the opportunity to look at tech packages within our classrooms. We are going to have at least 18 rooms upgraded – short throw projector, apple TV, sound system and direct wifi connection. Teachers receiving laptops as well as our education assistants. We have GAF accounts for virtually all our students and teachers.
