## DRESSING APPROPRIATELY FOR THE WEATHER

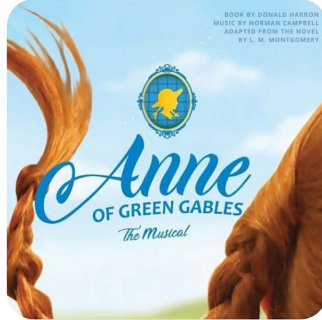
