**Chair's Report:** Victoria Family Court Justice Committee meeting tomorrow. Reminder to submit funding requests, have not not approved past requests, will revisit them tonight

Treasurer: Made 2 payments since last report:

- 1. \$75 VCPAC membership, will be returned
- \$2,130 allowed for classroom sports bags. \$5,000 committed for teachers' classrooms requests (\$2,350 approved so far)

## Beth Vice Principal Report:

- Trial year to see if the houses help to create community within a large school. 5 at North 3 at South
- Before break had "crest" contest to create for their houses, kids voted, revealed in past week. This week kids have been painting.
- Always looking for opportunities to bring South Campus kids up to North Campus, and ways for kids to engage with each other/other classes/houses
- Grade 8 Quebec trip coming up Feb 3rd-10th, another in May
- Entrepreneur Fair coming up at end of Feb. Every grade 6 class in involved for 1st time. Focus on renewable resources/eco friendly. North kids will come down to South to check it out. 81 kids going this year
- Question: is there any support for families who can't afford the financial commitment? Do jumpstart grants apply to it?
- Trips for English classes? More families in English challenged to afford trips/field trips

## **Previous Funding Requests**

- \$500 commitment to 1<sup>st</sup> Lego League : League needs new computers
  - Action: Carter to identify specific computing requirements
- BIPOC group : \$1500 for honoraria (funded 22 November)
- Yearbook Mini X \$800 for two Canon Powershot cameras
  - Are these the ones required? Other options available?
- Librarian: \$150 to tune the piano (funded 22 November)
- \$200 for glow forge plywood sheets and lather cords (funded 22 November)
- \$1500 Needle felting supplies (Advisory 65/66 felting a Salish Sea mural)
  - Could they look for donations / or provide breakdown : could fund a smaller amount
