CURRICULUM COMPLETION AFTERNOON TUESDAY, FEBRUARY 18

All ten middle schools in the Greater Victoria School District schedule 1.4 Curriculum Completion Days during each school year. These days are intended to provide additional time and opportunity for students with overdue or unsatisfactory school assignments to successfully complete their school work prior to each report card.

Lansdowne's Curriculum Completion sessions will run at both Campuses from 11:40 a.m. to 2:50 p.m. on:

Thursday, February 18

Thursday, June 5

Please mark these dates on your calendar. A letter will be sent home with each student in advance of the curriculum completion session. Advisory teachers sent home a letter on Wednesday, February 8th informing families whether a child is required or not required to attend the CC session. Should this requirement change prior to February 18th, you will receive a phone call from your child's advisory teacher.

On these CC days, all students are expected to come to school in the morning as usual. Beginning at 11:40 a.m., students required to attend will be organized into various locations to complete overdue or unsatisfactory assignments under the supervision of teachers and educational assistants. Students who are not required to stay for the CC session will be dismissed at 11:40 a.m. unless we hear from you that you would like your child



to stay at school even though current requirements are being met. In that case, your child will be provided with a quiet and supervised location to read and/or work quietly. More detailed information will be provided in the letter sent home in advance of each CC session.

STUDENT ABSENCE

We wish to be sure that all our students are safely accounted for on a daily basis, so please contact the school office – (250) 592-2170 (lansdownesouth@sd61.bc.ca) for Grade 6 and (250) 598-3336 (lansdowne@sd61.bc.ca) for Grade 7 & 8 – if you know that your child will be absent or late.

Also, please remind your child how very important it is that they sign in at the office when they are late - even one minute late. This allows the office to update the attendance and ensures that the school knows they are at school and may save you that "your child is away" message when you child is actually here.


