This is to notify you that construction of the [Richmond Road Improvement Project](#) is scheduled to begin in **mid-April**.

The District of Saanich, in partnership with the City of Victoria, are undertaking this project to deliver active transportation and safety upgrades along Richmond Road from Bay Street to Newton Street.

This project is a short-term priority under Saanich's [Active Transportation Plan](#) and aligns with mobility goals for both Saanich and the City of Victoria.

## **Project impacts**

Most of the work will involve single-lane alternating traffic along Richmond Road.

**Access for vehicles and bikes will be maintained, but delays are expected.**

*Please note: a full two-day road closure will be required for final paving near the end of construction (Fall 2026); advance notice and detour information will be provided.*
